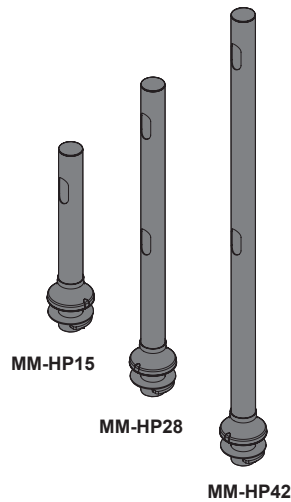


Introduction

The MM-HP15 is the 15" single pole for multi-monitor mounts with base for grommet hole installation. The MM-HP28 is the 28" version, and the MM-HP42 is the 42" version. These three different pole sizes provide more mounting options for those installing multi-monitor mounts. The larger the pole, the more displays that can be mounted per single base. The grommet hole base option installs on any tabletop with a standard 2 1/8" cable routing hole.

Step 1

Multi-monitor mounts with grommet hole bases easily intall on any tabletop with a standard 2 1/8" cable routing hole.

First, determine where you would like your multi-monitor mount positioned on your desired surface. The mounting surface should be capable of supporing 5x the weight of the flat-panel and mount. (Mount sold separately)

? Are you installing your pole to a surface with a pre-existing grommet hole?

If yes, procede to step 2...

If no, follow instructions below

Recommended tool for next step is a hole saw
(Not larger that 2 1/4") See figure 1 for example.

1. Drill a hole no larger that 2 1/4" though the desired surface with your hole saw.

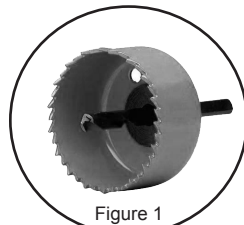
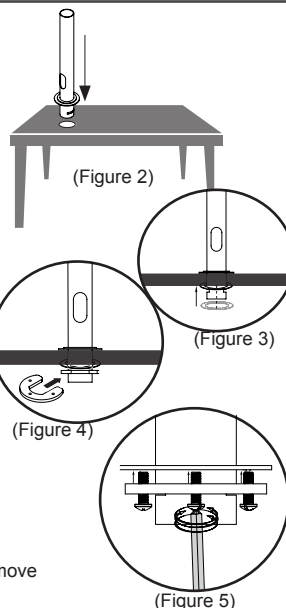

Step 2

1. Position your pole above the hole and place the pole through the hole until the welded steel ring is resting on the surface (Figure 2).
2. Slide the stabalizing steel ring up the bottom of the tube from below your installation surface (Figure 3).
3. Slide the horseshoe locking plate through the keyways on the bottom of the tube below the table (Figure 4).
4. Insert the (3) M6 x 20mm combination screws through the holes visible on the bottom of the horseshoe locking plate.
5. Screw them in until they are pressing the stabalizing ring tightly to the surface.

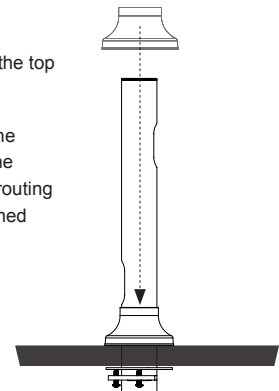

! Test the stability of the pole by trying to move it. It should remain sturdy and hold tight.

Step 3

Once you have made certain that the pole is secure to the surface

1. Slide the plastic tube cover over the top of the now secure pole.
2. The cover should be moved to the surface of the table to conceal the welded steel ring and the cable routing hole to provide a clean and finished appearance.

Its attachment head uses a 100 x 100mm VESA mounting pattern to fit a majority of flat-panels. For the optimal viewing angle, adjust the mount using its Radial Glide® feature, which offers up to 12° of smooth adjustment in any direction.

The VPM-100 fits 1-1/2" and 2" tubing, as well as Premier Mounts' own elliptical tubing, for carts, stands and ceiling poles. The mount's unique collar clasp design allows you to combine VPM-100s on a pole for back-to-back flat-panel installations.

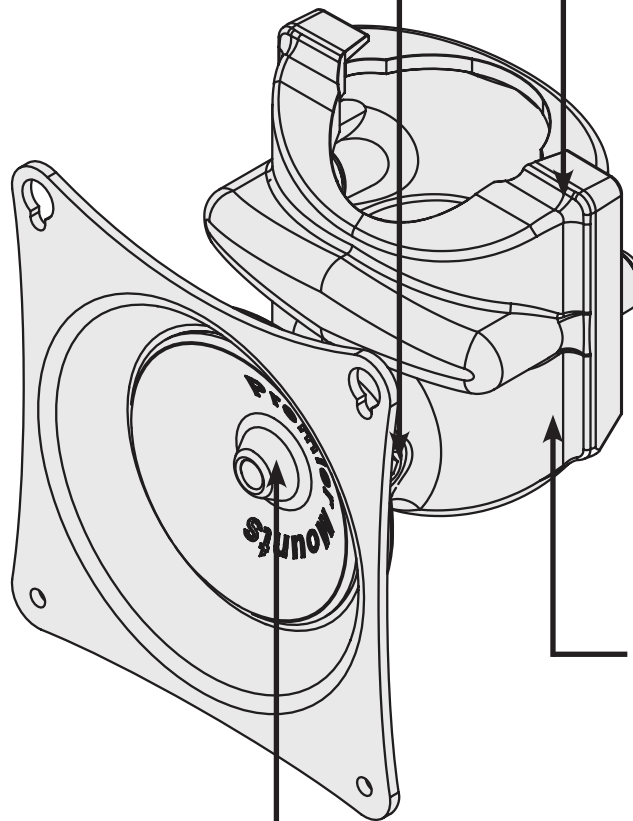
The VPM-100 also includes Lock-It™ security hardware to enhance security in every installation scenario.

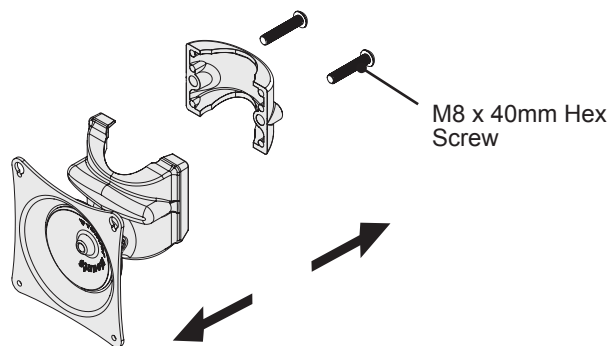
Radial Glide Technology™

The attachment head has 360° rotation and 12° of pivot for optimal viewing of your flat-panel.

Opening the Collar Clasp

Remove the M8 x 40mm hex screws from the sides of the VPM-100 to open the collar clasp and begin installation.

Proceed to the “**Attaching the Flat-Panel to the VPM-100 Mount**” section.



Attaching the Flat-Panel to the VPM-100 Mount

Insert four (4) M4 x 10mm screws through the VPM-100 attachment head and 100 x 100mm pattern of the flat-panel.

You may use either the M4 x 10mm pan combo or security screws that are in the hardware pack.

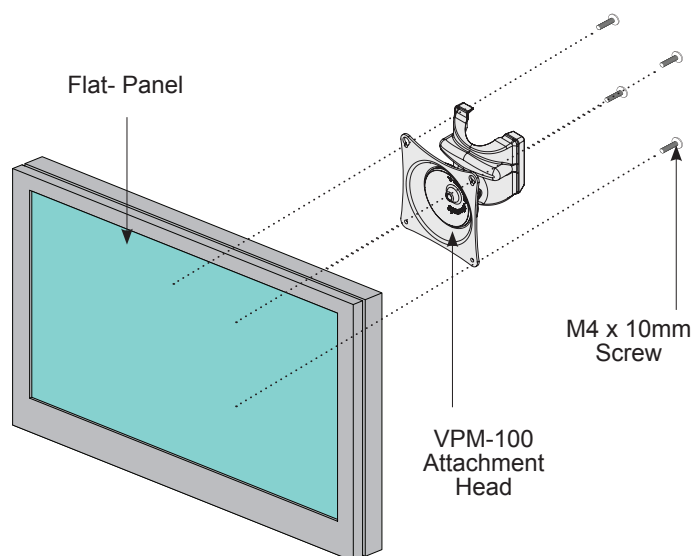


If the M4 x 10 screws are too short for the flat-panel, use the M4 x 12mm pan combo or security screws instead.



Do not overtighten the mounting hardware.

Proceed to the “**Attaching the VPM-100 Mount to a Pole**” section.





Attaching the VPM-100 Mount to a Pole

Re-insert the M8 x 40mm hex screws or insert M8 x 40mm security screws into the two halves of the VPM-100 to clasp them around the pole at the desired position (Figure 1).

 At least two qualified people are needed to attach the flat-panel and VPM-100 to a pole.

 If you are using a 2" pipe, replace the M8 x 40mm hex screws with M8 x 60mm security screws (Figure 2).

Proceed to the **“Adjusting the VPM-100 Mount Tension”** section.

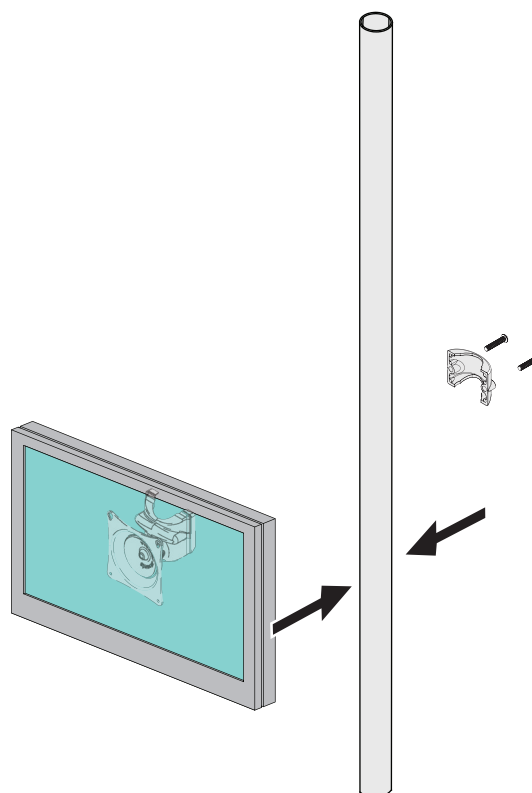

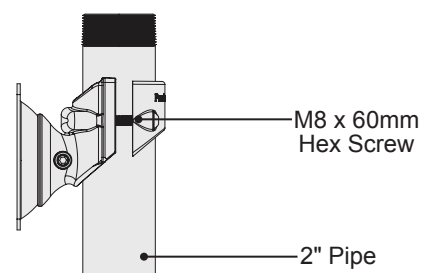


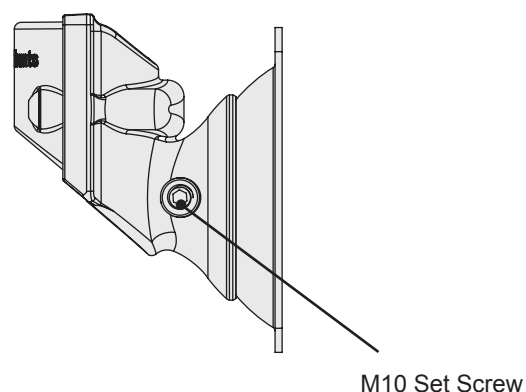

Adjusting the VPM-100 Mount Tension

Your VPM-100 ships from the factory pre-tensioned. However, you can fine-tune adjust the amount of pressure required to move the attachment head of the VPM-100.

Use the M5 security Allen wrench to adjust the tension by loosening or tightening the M10 set screws pre-installed on each side of the VPM-100.

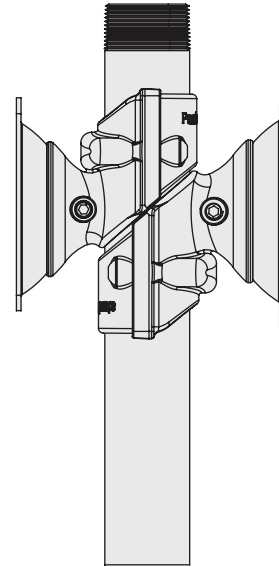
 Do not overtighten or remove the set screws.





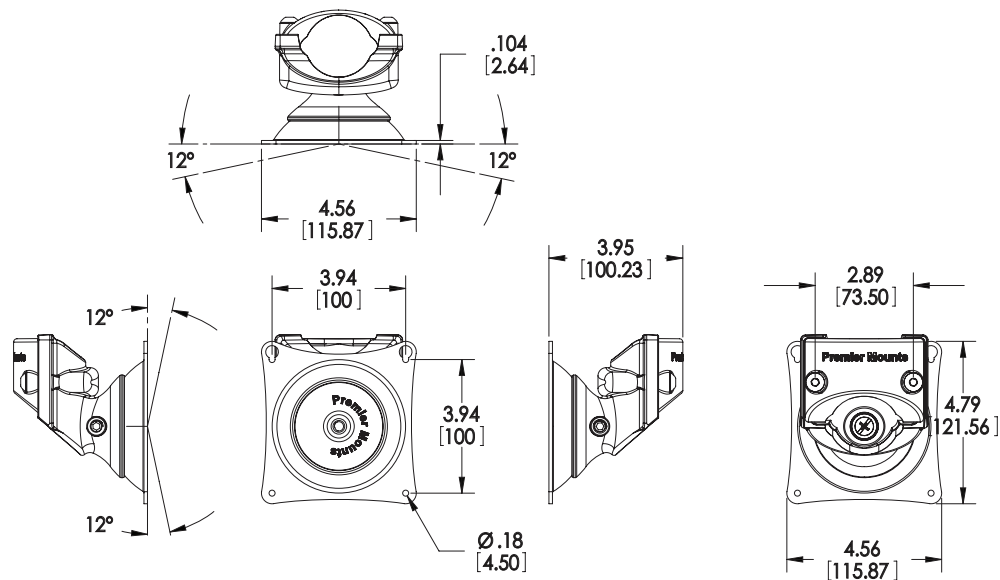
Installing Multiple VPM-100s (Optional)
